Mandatory One-Year Learner's Permit

AN ACT

An act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) to increase the time an individual must hold a learner's permit from six months to one year.

Section 1. An individual must possess a learner's permit for a minimum of one year before becoming eligible to apply for a full driver's license.

Section 2. The Department of Transportation shall not issue a driver's license until an individual has completed all required supervised driving hours and has possessed a learner's permit for at least one year.

Section 3. The Department may establish an incentive program for individuals who complete the learner's permit period without a traffic violation.

Section 4. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
